## Carla's Round Tree Skirt

60 inches round


1 Sew strips of blocks together for Side A and then Side B.

The Blocks
Finished 6" square
Cut 886.5 inch blocks
from five different fabrics.
A - 18
B-17
C-18
D-17
E-18

Using a quarter inch seam allowance sew the blocks together as shown.
2. Sew Sides $A$ and $B$ together. (front only)


Join Side $A$ and $B$ by sewing from the center to the front. Leave the seam open from the center to the back.
3. Trim the pieced blocks into a round skirt and cut out a hole for the trunk.

Trim the outside of the quilt to make a round circle.

Trim the inside to make a circle for around the tree. Cut an 8 or $81 / 2$ inch circle - when you finish the skirt with a quarter inch seam the hole should be $81 / 2$ to 9 inches to accommodate the trunk of the tree.

4. Cut backing and batting the same size as the skirt.
5. Options-
a. A dd ruffle and lace to the edge of the skirt. Layer with batting and backing to right side of blocks; sew inside out and turn right side out.
b. Layer with batting and backing to back side of blocks ( with plans to add binding after the quilting.
6. Hand or machine quilt, or tie quilt.
