


Carla's Round Tree Skirt

1. Sew strips of blocks together for Side A and then Side B.

2. Sew Sides A and B together. (front only)




Join Side A and B by sewing from the center to the front. Leave the seam open from the center to the back.

3. Trim the pieced blocks into a round skirt and cut out a hole for the trunk.

Trim the outside of the quilt to make a round circle.

Trim the inside to make a circle for around the tree. Cut an 8 or 8 1/2inch circle – when you finish the skirt with a quarter inch seam the hole should be 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ to 9 inches to accommodate the trunk of the tree.



- 4. Cut backing and batting the same size as the skirt.
- 5. Options
 - a. Add ruffle and lace to the edge of the skirt. Layer with batting and backing to right side of blocks; sew inside out and turn right side out.
 - b. Layer with batting and backing to back side of blocks (with plans to add binding after the quilting.
- 6. Hand or machine quilt, or tie quilt.
