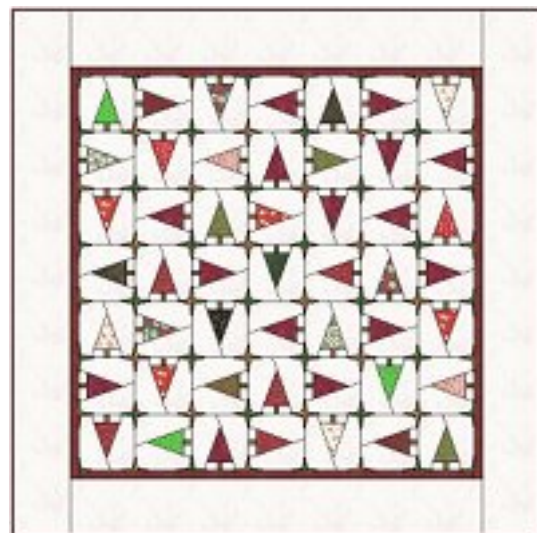
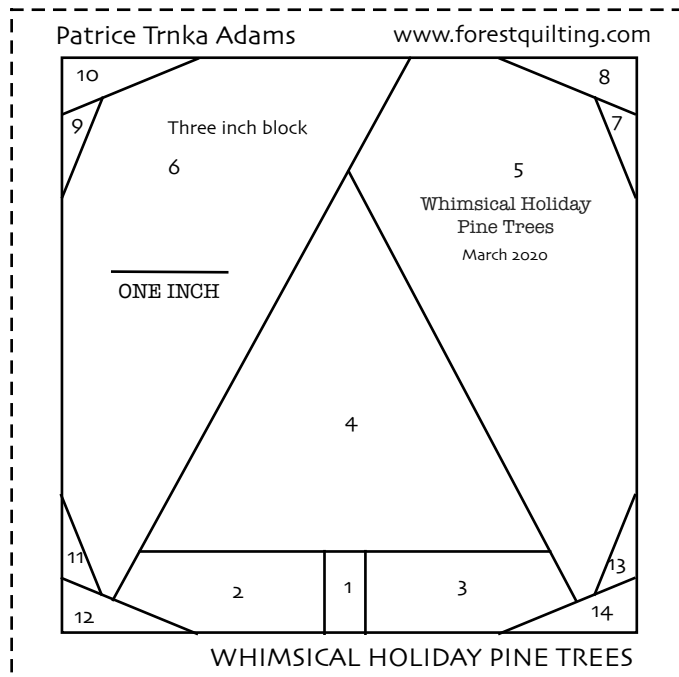
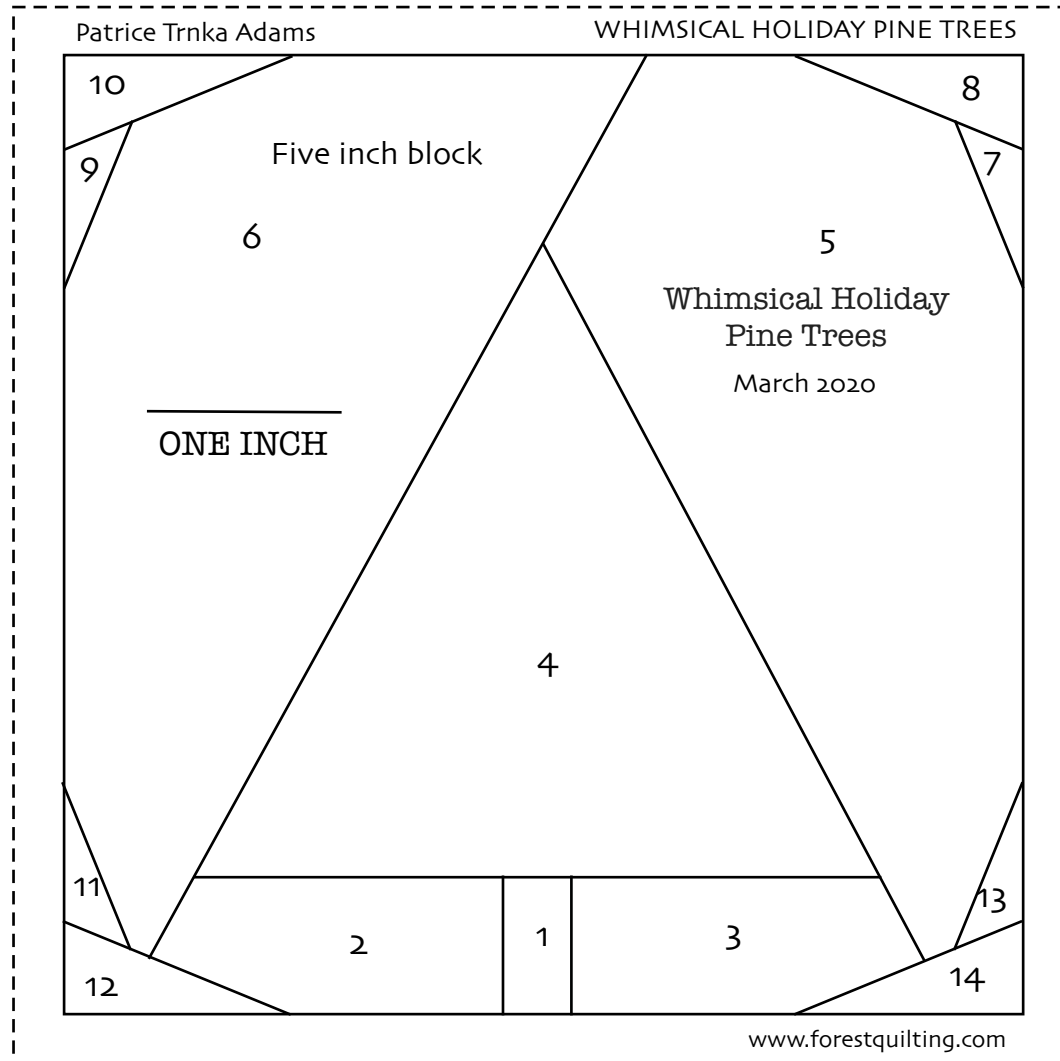
Whimsical Holiday Pine Trees

March 2020

I made this as a large wallhanging 58.5 inches square using the 7" blocks
7 blocks square (49") Sashing (1") Border (4") Binding (.25")

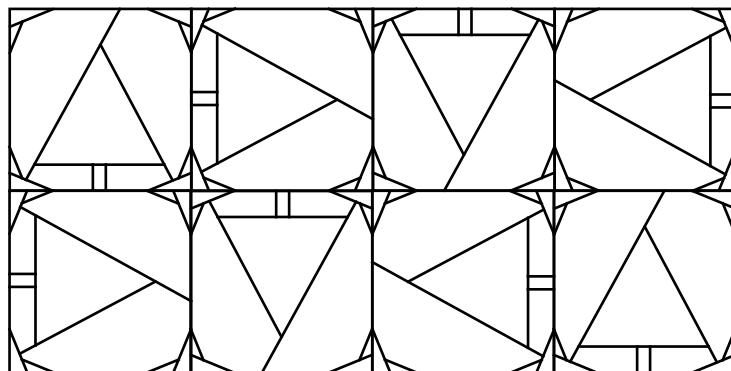
I have included two additional sizes of the blocks for you.





Whimsical Holiday Pine Trees

March 2020



INSTRUCTIONS

(49) SEVEN inch blocks, with sashing, border, and binding)

YARDAGE:

Tree blocks background 1 1/2 yards

Trees and Trunks - variety of themed fabrics, approximately 3/4 yard total

Sashing 1/4 yard

Border 1/2 yard

Bias binding 27 inch square of fabric or 1/2 yard



DIRECTIONS:

1. Copy the seven-inch square PP pattern of the tree - 49 copies
2. Use the background for the spaces around the tree.
3. Sew the 49 PP blocks. Use a variety of fabrics for the tree body, and corners. Use a medium brown or gray for the tree trunks.
4. Assemble the tree blocks as desired. You can use my example if you like for a random orientation appearance.
5. CAREFULLY remove the paper.
6. Cut three crosswise strips WOF (1.5 inches) for the sashing. Sew the strips together. Add to the sides of the assembled blocks.
7. Cut four crosswise strips WOF (4.5 inches) for the border. Sew the strips together. Add to the the sashing.
8. Cut bias fabric for the binding to make 250 inches of binding.
9. Layer the quilt with batting and backing.
10. Quilt as desired.
11. Add the binding.
