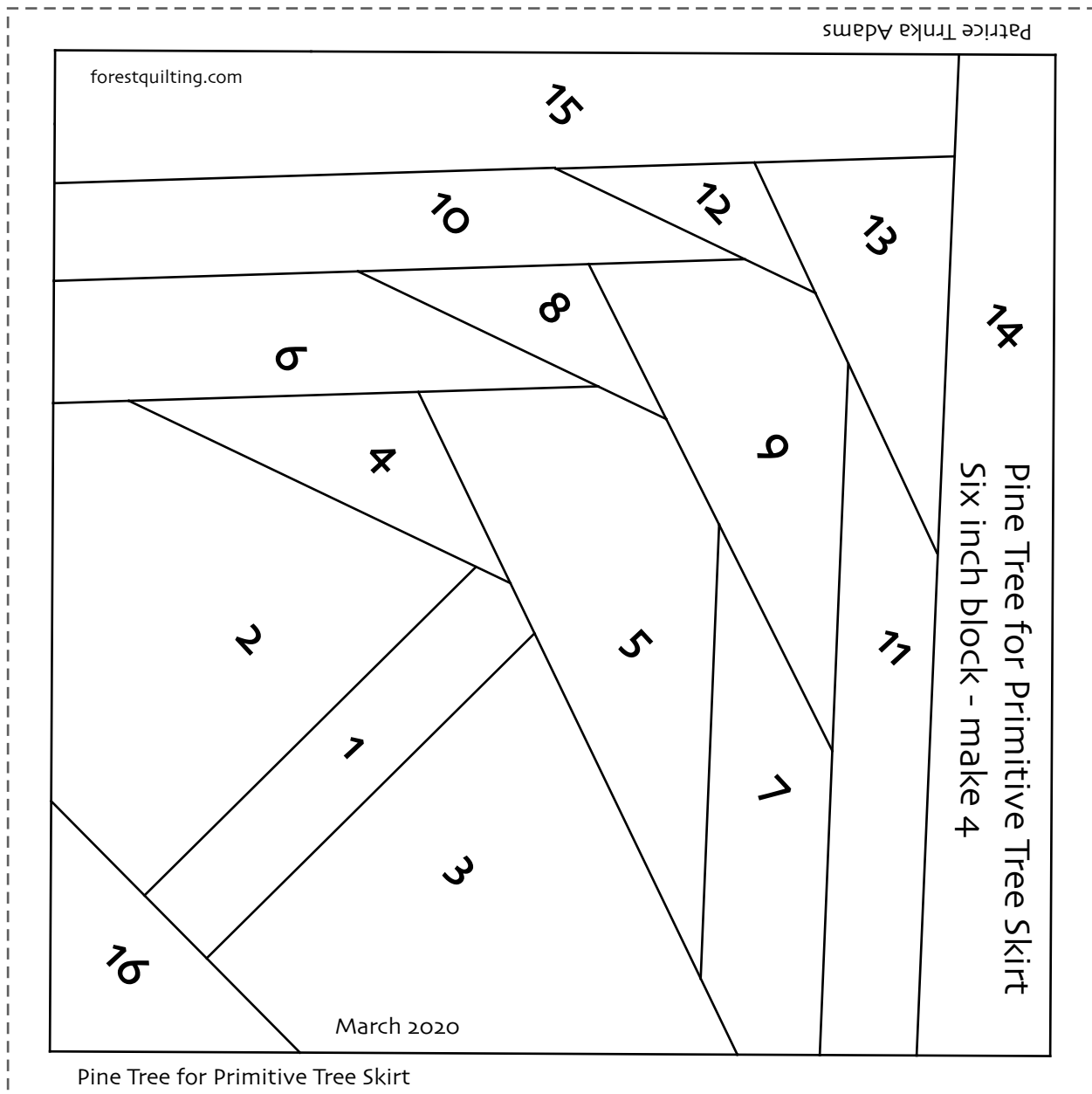
## Primitive Tree Skirt (pine tree)

March 2020

This tree skirt measures 23 inches in diameter after the binding is added.

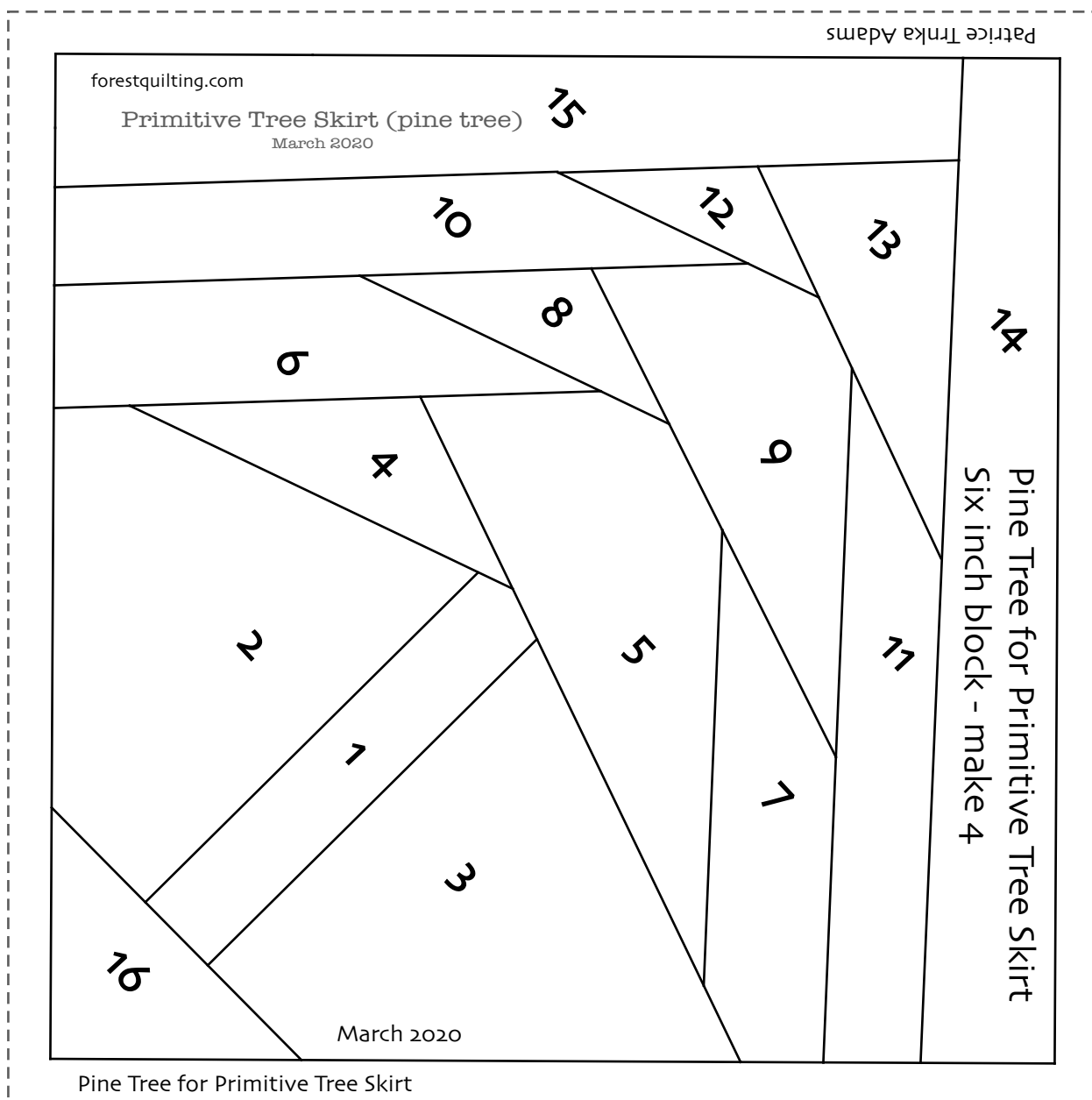


DIRECTIONS:

- 1.) Make 4 six-inch paper-pieced pine trees.
- 2.) Add fabric borders to each block to create an eight-inch tree block.
- 3.) Sew the blocks together.
- 4.) Add the four half-circles to the assembled blocks. (See Figure A)
- 5.) Remove the paper from the tree blocks
- 6.) Cut a center opening to accommodate your three trunk.
- 7.) Layer with batting and a backing. Quilt or secure your layers.
- 8.) Make a cut from the edge of the skirt to the center opening.
- 9.) Bind the tree skirt.



I have several artificial pine trees and the skirt works well to cover the metal stand. Colors can vary to coordinate with your other decor, or you can choose to make this seasonal! Have fun.



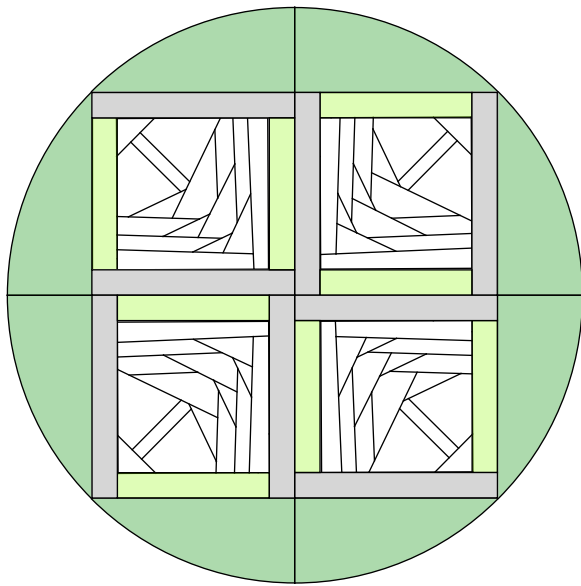
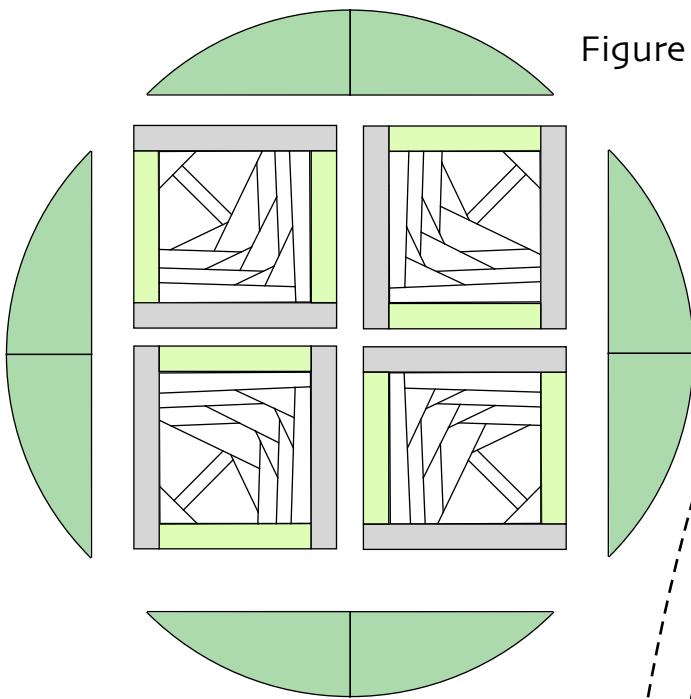
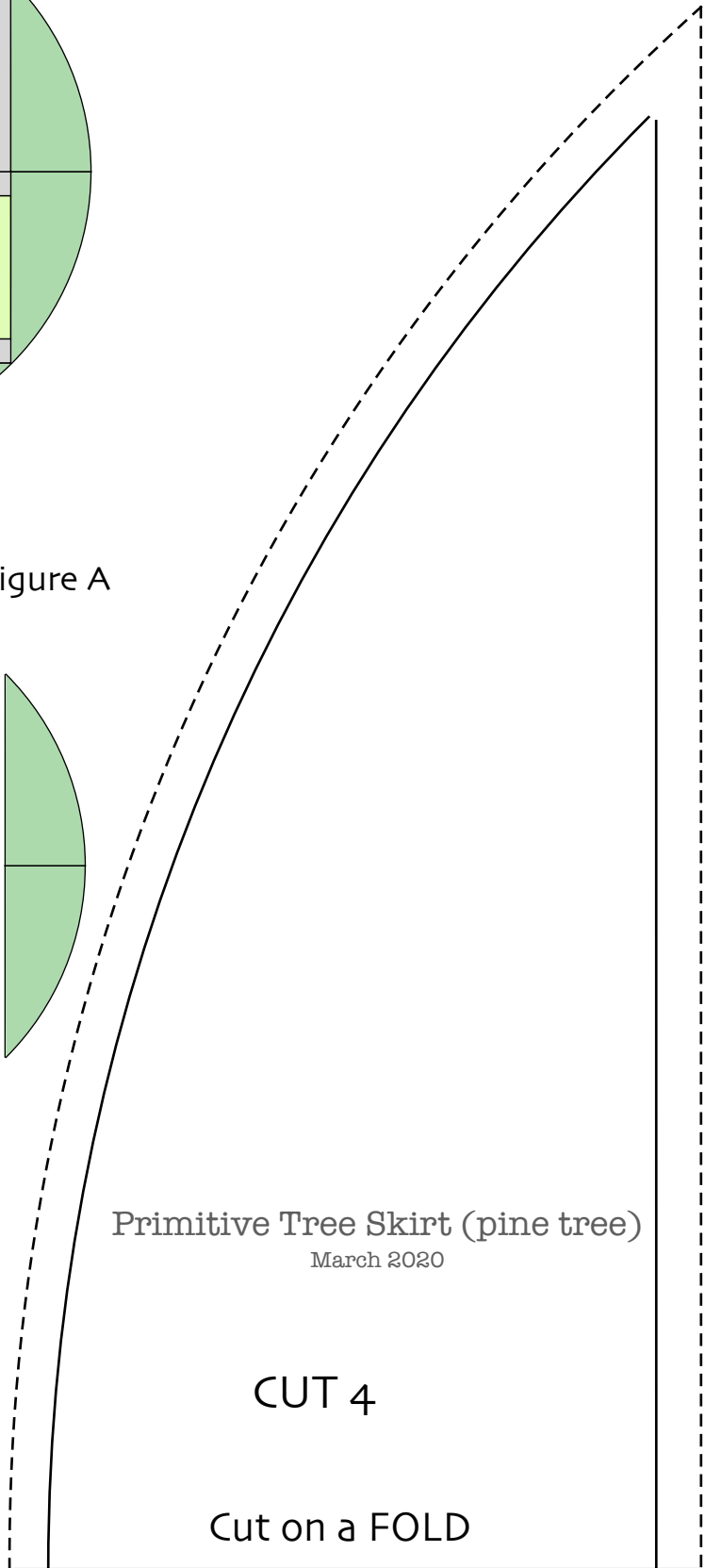
