**FIRST: BE CERTAIN THAT THE PATTERN HAS PRINTED TO THE PROPER SCALE.**

This is an intermediate pattern because of all the pieces and units involved. Careful pinning and sewing will determine success.

I use very small stitches when I paper-piece so that the stitches do not show when the seam is opened; however, that is a challenge if I have to un-sew a seam.

### ASSEMBLY DIRECTIONS:

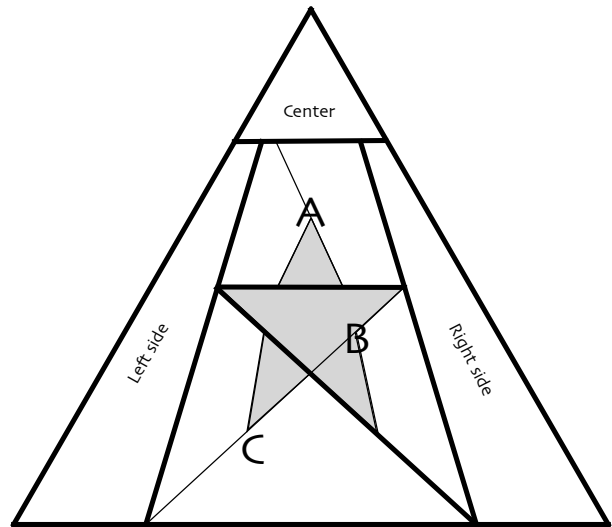
1. Sew A to B
2. Sew AB to C
3. Add the sides
4. Add the center

Sew 6 of these units.

Join the units together by sewing three together and then joining the three-unit pieces together.

Be careful to not stretch the fabric. By this time the paper may be a mess...hang in there.

Once the pieces are all sewn together, carefully remove the paper.
