SIZE ADULT MEDIUM
7 1/8 inches x 10 inches
Trim corners

one inch
square

CUT ONE OF OUTSIDE FABRIC
CUT ONE OF LINING FABRIC

Note from Pat

I have a sheet of aluminum (Menards or Home Depot) that I cut with a scissors and insert in my masks. Others have used coffee bag metal closures or wire.

For the loops over the ears I use t-shirt fabric cut 3/4 inch wide and stretched. I use two pony beads on each side - one for a stop and the other for adjusting the tightness. For the adult medium I make my loops 7 - 8 inches long.

I have not added the filter pocket.

Other than how I do the straps, I make my masks from this pattern just like the video. They are really comfy and sew together quickly.

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
